**SETH MERROW & KYLE BROWNELL TO HANDICAP THE FLORIDA
& KENTUCKY DERBIES AT PGR MEETING**

Saratoga Springs, N.Y. – **Seth Merrow and Kyle Brownell**, nationally recognized handicappers, will guest speak at the monthly [Parting Glass Racing](http://www.PartingGlassRacing.com) meeting on Thursday, March 26, 2009 at 7:00 p.m. at the Parting Glass Pub, 40 Lake Avenue, Saratoga Springs, New York. In the second of our 3-part series, the March meeting will feature Merrow and Brownell discussing their projections for the Florida Derby (March 28th) and Kentucky Derby (May 2nd). Seth Merrow is the publisher of *Equidaily.com*, one of the internet's most popular sources of daily horse racing news. Merrow is also a host/handicapper on Capital OTB-TV and a regular weekly guest on Sirius satellite radio's *At the Races* with Steve Byk. **Kyle Brownell** has been the horse racing handicapper and racing analyst for The Post-Star (Glens Falls, N.Y.) since 2002, and ranked as the top handicapper at the 2006 Saratoga race meet. He is a regular television host of several programs on the Capital OTB-TV and has been a panelist at racing seminars for the National Museum of Racing and Hall of Fame and the Albany Tele-Theater.
