PGR Celebrates a Spectacular Win Streak!

Saratoga Springs, N.Y. – Parting Glass Racing enjoyed a spectacular Memorial Day long weekend of racing, with 2 wins in 3 starts:

- On Thursday, May 21st, **Reeley Misbehaving** won her 3rd start, breaking from the 2 hole in the 6th race at Belmont Park with jockey 'Romancin' Ramon Dominguez aboard. Trained by Barclay Tagg, she broke nicely, relaxed and hung back, then beginning at the 3/4 pole, she made her move on the turn, going from last to first in a 1/4 mile to win brilliantly by 2 lengths. NYRA's Tom Durkin did not resist his typical poetry when he called, "***Reeley Misbehaving is picking off horses one by one, moving like a shot down the outside....she just inhaled the last 5 horses...catapulting past the field on the far turn, it's Reeley Misbehaving in control at the top of the stretch!***"
- On Sunday, May 24th, **Averymerrymoment** gave her owners a Very Merry Moment in her 4th start when she battled to the wire to win the 5th race at Belmont Park with Eibar Coa aboard. She broke a little bit sharp and Coa took her back and got her behind horses. She fought him at first but then she relaxed, tucked in, took him 4 wide on the turn and headed for home. She drew off to win by 1/2 a length in a contested stretch battle. She is also trained by Barclay Tagg.

- In addition, another horse managed by PGR Owner Tom Gallo, **Nehantic Kat**, ran 2nd to I Lost My Choo in the Mt. Vernon Stake Race at Belmont Park on Sunday, May 17th. With Rajiv 'the Magician' Maragh in the irons, Nehantic Kat ran an incredible race and was able to finish a closing 2nd in her first race in 7 months, against stiff competition going a distance that is not her favorite. She is trained by Barclay Tagg.

Managing Owner Tom Gallo could not contain his reaction to the recent racing excitement when he stated, "To win one race is extra special, but to win 2 on the same weekend seems unbelievable, especially having just finished 2nd in the Mt. Vernon a week earlier. All our horses are running super, and it looks like we're going to have a hot stable in Saratoga this summer!"
