PARTING GLASS RACING BOASTS TWO NOMINEES FOR NY-BRED CHAMPIONS

Saratoga Springs, N.Y. – [Parting Glass Racing](http://www.PartingGlassRacing.com) boasts two of their stable roster who have been nominated by the New York Thoroughbred Breeders (NYTB) for prestigious recognition as 2007 NY-Bred Champions. The nominations are an honor bestowed on those New York Bred racehorses who have demonstrated superior ability in their respective categories. The winners are selected by majority vote of New York State Turf Writers and will be named at the annual NYTB awards banquet in May.

- Cute Cognac, recently retired after a spectacular stakes winning racing career that included 5 starts, 3 wins, and 2 seconds, including a first place finish at the Office Miss Stakes race at Belmont's Fall 2007 Showcase Day, has been nominated in the Three Year Old Female category. Cute Cognac sold at the Fasig-Tipton Kentucky Winter Mixed Sale in February for a whopping \$180,000.
- Dave, currently nominated for Gulfstream Park's Gr II Mac Diarmida Handicap on March 16th, has been nominated in the Four Year Old Male and Turf Male categories. Dave has enjoyed an impressive career, including his win of the Gr 2 Red Smith Handicap at Aqueduct in November 2007.

Both Cute Cognac and Dave were active racehorses in 2007 owned in partnership through Parting Glass Racing, a Saratoga-based horse racing partnership organization. Parting Glass Racing was founded by Tom Gallo and Joan Desadora (owner of The Parting Glass Pub) in 2001. With more than 200 members, Parting Glass Racing, LLC is the umbrella organization managing several partnerships and horses. Parting Glass Racing has an office in downtown Saratoga Springs, NY, and holds its monthly meeting at the Parting Glass Pub. The meeting is free and open to the public.
