**KENTUCKY DERBY WINTER BOOK HANDICAPPING SERIES  
PANEL #2**

Saratoga Springs, N.Y. – Parting Glass Racing will host a handicapping panel to discuss & handicap the **Kentucky Derby Winter Book** picks at the monthly meeting of Parting Glass Racing, Saratoga’s original horse racing partnership, on Thursday, **March 22**, 2007 at 7:00 p.m. at The Parting Glass Pub, located at 40 Lake Avenue, Saratoga Springs, New York. The meeting is **free and open to the public.**

In the second of our 3-part series, our March meeting will feature a powerhouse panel of local celebrity handicappers including **Kyle Brownell**, horse racing handicapper and racing analyst for the *Glens Falls Post Star*; **Bev Swimm**, horse racing handicapper and blogger for the *Albany Times Union*; **Bill Heller**, Eclipse Award-winning author; **Jeanne Wood**, handicapper for Capital OTB; and **Nick Kling**, thoroughbred racing columnist and handicapper for *The (Troy) Record* and co-host of the Capital OTB show "Trackfacts." The panel will be moderated by **Mike Kane**, Communications Officer for the National Museum of Racing.

The handicappers will discuss and handicap one of the best kept betting secrets in the world of horseracing: the "Kentucky Derby Future Wagers". Tom Gallo, PGR’s managing member, predicts that “you’ll get expert wagering advice on placing your winter book bets - you can get a huge price on a horse that might 20 to 1 now but will be 2 to 1 in May. It’s not just fun ~ your winter book bet could be one of your **best bets of the year!**”
