TOM GALLO & SEAN CLANCY LAUNCH RADIO SHOW

In addition to his management of Parting Glass Racing, Tom has worked in the thoroughbred horse industry for 30 years. He sells about 100 yearlings, weanlings, and broodmares annually at public auction and owns 12 mares in private partnership at his 100-acre Blue Stone Farm. Former steeplechase jockey Sean Clancy publishes **The Saratoga Special** daily during the Saratoga Racetrack meet. He is the editor/publisher of ST Publishing based in Fair Hill, Maryland and is the author of *Saratoga Days*, *The Best of the Saratoga Special*, and *Barbaro: the Horse Who Captured America's Heart*. His writings have also appeared in the Daily Racing Form, the Blood Horse, Mid-Atlantic Thoroughbred and Newsweek
