**PARTING GLASS RACING LAUNCHES A NEW PARTNERSHIP
WITH DEPUTY COMMANDER FILLY**

Saratoga Springs, N.Y. – Parting Glass Racing, LLC announced it has syndicated for partnership the 2005 filly by Deputy Commander out of Axe Creek. A limited number of units are immediately available.

The sire of this magnificent filly also sired the Travers Grade 1 Stakes winner, **Ten Most Wanted**. The filly is a ½ sister to **Celtic Sky**, a multiple stakes winner at both Belmont and Saratoga, winning both the Kingston and the West Point Handicaps twice each, and is a ½ sister to **Cloon**, a multiple-graded Stakes filly who won in France in some of the most difficult graded stakes races on the French turf schedule. This Deputy Commander filly represents the most influential cross that has produced Deputy Commander's biggest horses. She is a registered NY-bred and is fully nominated to the Breeders' Cup and OBS Championship series.
