**PARTING GLASS RACING TRAINER BILL SANBORN TO BE  
HIGHLIGHTED ON NBC DOCUMENTARY**

Saratoga Springs, N.Y. – Parting Glass Racing trainer Bill Sanborn will be interviewed as part of an NBC special, “Barbaro, A Nation’s Horse” to air at 5 p.m. on Sunday, April 29, 2007. Barbaro became a household name after winning the 2006 Kentucky Derby, then shattering his leg two weeks later in the Preakness. Barbaro’s 8 month battle to recover is detailed in the documentary, with interviews with his main team of owners, trainers, and caregivers, including Bill Sanborn.

Sanborn is the General Manager for Wimbledon Farm in Lexington, Kentucky, and is one of Parting Glass Racing's finest resources for working with young PGR horses prior to racing training. Prior to joining Wimbledon Farm, Bill owned Sanborn Chase Farm where Barbaro was foaled and raised. Bill and Parting Glass Racing’s managing member, Tom Gallo, have been working together successfully for almost 25 years. According to Tom, “When you call Bill, you feel secure knowing he’s right there ~ handling the horses, adjusting the bridles, and standing next to the veterinarians. He’s the ultimate horsemen’s horseman.”

Parting Glass Racing, Saratoga’s original racing partnership, was founded by Tom Gallo and Joan Desadora (owner of the Parting Glass Pub in Saratoga Springs) in 2001. With more than 150 members, Parting Glass Racing, LLC is the umbrella organization managing several partnerships and horses.
