**THOROUGHBRED TIMES MANAGING EDITOR AND PARTING
GLASS RACING TRAINERS TO SPEAK AT NEXT MEETING**

Saratoga Springs, N.Y. – *Thoroughbred Times* Managing Editor, **Tom Law**, will guest speak along with Parting Glass Racing trainers **Bruce Levine** and **Barclay Tagg** at the **Parting Glass Racing** meeting on Thursday, August 23, 2007 at 7:00 p.m. at the **Parting Glass Pub**, located at 40 Lake Avenue in Saratoga Springs, New York. The meeting is free and open to the public.

Tom Law is the Managing Editor of *Thoroughbred Times*, a weekly newsmagazine about thoroughbred racing and breeding based in Lexington, Kentucky. A Saratoga Springs native and graduate of Saratoga High School, Tom was a sports writer for the *Saratogian* and has handicapped for the Pink Sheet every Saratoga meet since 1995. Tom is a two-time winner of the Bill Leggett Breeders' Cup Magazine Writing Award and the 2003 Red Smith Kentucky Derby Writing Award. He is President of the National Turf Writers Association.

As a licensed trainer for 25 years, **Bruce Levine** has trained nearly 50 stakes winners, won over 500 races and \$11 million in purses, trained two NY-bred champions, and has been ranked in the top ten trainers in both Aqueduct and Saratoga meets in the past ten years. Bruce currently trains Parting Glass Racing's **Pouf Positive**.

After retiring as a steeplechase rider, **Barclay Tagg** turned to training racehorses in 1971. Tagg, who primarily trains on the Northeast circuit, found his fame as the trainer to the famous gelding, Funny Cide. In 2003, Tagg celebrated Funny Cide's wins at the Kentucky Derby and Preakness. He also won the 2003 Alabama with the filly Island Fashion. Barclay currently trains Parting Glass Racing's **Cute Cognac** and **Dave**.

Parting Glass Racing was founded by Tom Gallo and Joan Desadora (owner of The Parting Glass Pub) in 2001. With more than 200 members, Parting Glass Racing, LLC is the umbrella organization managing several partnerships and horses. Their meeting is held every month at the Parting Glass Pub and is open to the public.
